## Transport for Young People in Lower Nidderdale

Providing a transport network in Nidderdale for **young people in school year 8 and above**, consisting of return journeys in the evening from village to village, in order to connect young people with youth provision and facilities in neighbouring villages and towns.

### Hampsthwaite Youth Club

.....offers a programme of exciting activities for young people such as Art, Music, Playstation, TV, Cooking, Themed Nights, Youth Council, Outdoor Pursuits and accreditation such as Duke of Edinburgh, Youth Achievement Awards and others.....

All young people need to be registered with “4Youth Travel” before travelling.

To register, each young person will need to complete a consent form and hand it to the Youth Worker on the minibus on their first journey. If you do not have a registration form please ring the number below and one will be sent to you in the post.

The transport has a trained driver and an experienced Youth Worker to support the young people on the minibus, escort them into the destination youth club/centre and return with them on the minibus to ensure they arrive back safely. The driver and youth worker will both carry identification.

“4Youth Travel” is a multi-agency initiative and fully supported by Harrogate & District Strategic Partnership.
